10 Tips to Matching the Right Variety to the Field

(Burlington, Colo.)

1. Know the field's yield potential.
2. Choose high yielding varieties from test plot data.
3. Follow best pest management practices.
4. Follow practices that will get the best stands.
5. Adjust planting rates field by field
6. Apply correct fertilizers at best economical rates (soil test).
7. Till only when necessary.
8. Rotate crops.
9. Monitor a field's performance often.
10. Re-evaluate what worked and what didn't by field at season's end.
