From 2009 to 2011 area Colorado Master Gardeners have raised a total of \$1,764

Fundraisers were selling bulbs and selling local honey along with donations from the Methodist Church in Holyoke. Fresh food is provided for an annual dinner for low-income families.

Farmers' Markets have been started in Akron (Washington County) and Burlington (Kit Carson County). With assistance from Future Farmers of America, Extension is partnering to build a more permanent infrastructure for the Farmers' Market.
